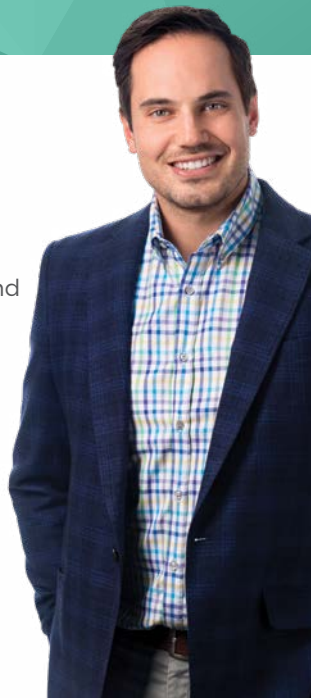
Welcome to the June edition of our newsletter!

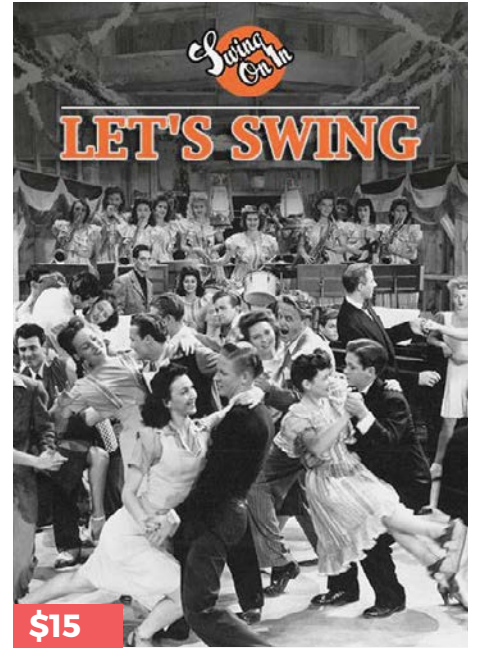
